County staff has been involved over the past year in working with school officials and also community members, particularly those representing trails, to scope a proposal that will provide for both pedestrian and equestrian use on Rider Street. As a result of these discussions, we are recommending that a sidewalk be installed on the south side of Rider between Lee and Haines, which would extend the sidewalk from the community center to the crosswalk installed for the school at Haines and to connect with the sidewalk in front of the school. As part of this project, a trail would be constructed along the north side of Rider between Brown and Haines consisting of a graded path and including PVC trail fencing (Phase I trail).

The Transportation Department will also work with the Parks Department and the Economic Development Agency to continue the trail implementation (Phase II) to connect to the Boulder Springs development to the west.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. Environmental clearance is complete.
