**BACKGROUND:**

Since 1998, the United San Diego Regional Youth Department has organized a Regional Youth Leadership Conference attended by over 500 teens. The purpose of the conference is to help deter negative influences and behaviors in teens by providing leadership training, responsible living information and education incentives.

Teens that live in the Palo Verde Valley and Coachella Valley will benefit from attending this annual event that teaches positive life learning skills and discourages negative behavior.

In the past, the event was less expensive to hold because it was held at a church. However, this year the event will be at an alternate site that charges for meeting rooms, overnight accommodations, and food. There is also a transportation cost. The non-profit organizers have been able to raise a portion of the money but their efforts have fallen short of the required funds.

We would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to assist this organization in their efforts to have as many teenagers attend this important conference.
