SUBJECT: Acceptance of a Grant Award for Additional Funding for the Sheriff's Domestic Violence Emergency Response Team

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the Chairperson to accept, on behalf of the Board, a \$10,500 grant award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Sheriff's Domestic Violence Emergency Response Team.
2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A.

BACKGROUND: In FY 2003-04, FY 2004-05, and again in FY 2005-2006 (9/27/05, 3.43), the Office of Emergency Services awarded funds to the County for a three-year pilot project to implement a multi-departmental team to respond to incidents where children have been directly or indirectly exposed to domestic violence. The Sheriff's Department utilized the funds to create the Domestic Violence Emergency Response Team, DVERT, which operates out of the Lake Elsinore Sheriff's Station.

The Stockton Police Department is concurrently conducting a similar project in Northern California, and the two teams often collaborate on ways to improve and expand upon service delivery. Stockton PD awarded Harder+Company, through competitive bids, a consulting contract to carrying out a comprehensive evaluation of both programs.

This is the final funding year of the pilot project and the Office of Emergency Services has awarded additional funds for Harder+Company to continue the comprehensive comparison evaluation of the programs on behalf of both Departments.
