SUBJECT: Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the City of Perris.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the Fifth District, Youth Advisory Council Mural Project, in the city of Perris at Foss Park.
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

Increase Appropriations:	\$4,000
10000-1000100000-536200	Contributions to Other N-Co. Agency
Decrease Board Designation:	\$4,000
10000-1000100000-320135	Community Improvement

BACKGROUND: The Fifth District's Youth Advisory Council intends to acquire funding for the mural designated at Foss Park in order to beautify the growing community of Perris. The total cost, including supplies and labor for the project are expected to be over \$5,000, and with the assistance of Riverside County's Community Improvement Designation Fund, this project will come into fruition.

The mural will highlight the growing community of Perris but it will also illustrate the historical significance in the city of Perris. Furthermore, it will provide the park with an amazing artistic creation from a renowned muralist with the labor and creative assistance of the 5th district, Youth Advisory Council.

In addition, it will serve as a symbol of unity amongst youth and it will also show the importance of how they too can make a positive impact on the community with artist expression.
