BACKGROUND: Continued

acute episode of mental illness for Riverside County indigent consumers who are non Medi-Cal eligible under Title 22, Section 51001. Services include clinical and medical services, which are generally recognized and accepted for the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness or serious emotional disturbance, as clinically necessary.

The increase to contract maximum obligation of the indigent inpatient services contract with Valley Health System, consisting of services provided at Hemet Valley Medical Center and Moreno Valley Community Hospital, is necessary due to the increased level of services provided.
