**BACKGROUND:**

On March 8, 2006, a public notice was filed in the Federal Register announcing the availability of Continuum of Care (Supportive Housing Program, Shelter Plus Care and Section 8 Moderate Rehab) funds through the annual Super Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) competition.

Since 1996 the County of Riverside has submitted a consolidated application to HUD on behalf of Homeless Project sponsors who provide services for homeless persons in Riverside County. From 1996 through 2003, through the Economic Development Agency and then through the Department of Public Social Services, a total of approximately \$36 million has been made available to these programs to provide services to homeless persons in Riverside County. In 2005, the County was awarded approximately \$6.1 million. This year the County has been assigned a pro-rata need of \$5.2 million, with an opportunity to receive a bonus of \$750,000 depending upon the amount allocated for permanent housing for the disabled in our first priority project.

This year we are submitting three new applications and requesting funding to renew 17 projects. A total of \$6.2 million is being requested.

The applications were reviewed and ranked by the Steering Committee for the Housing and Homeless Coalition for the County of Riverside on April 25, 2006. Since that time, staff has been working with applicant and renewal agencies to make corrections to their applications. Most of this task has been completed; however, some final revisions may need to be made to the final application, with your Honorable Board's approval.
