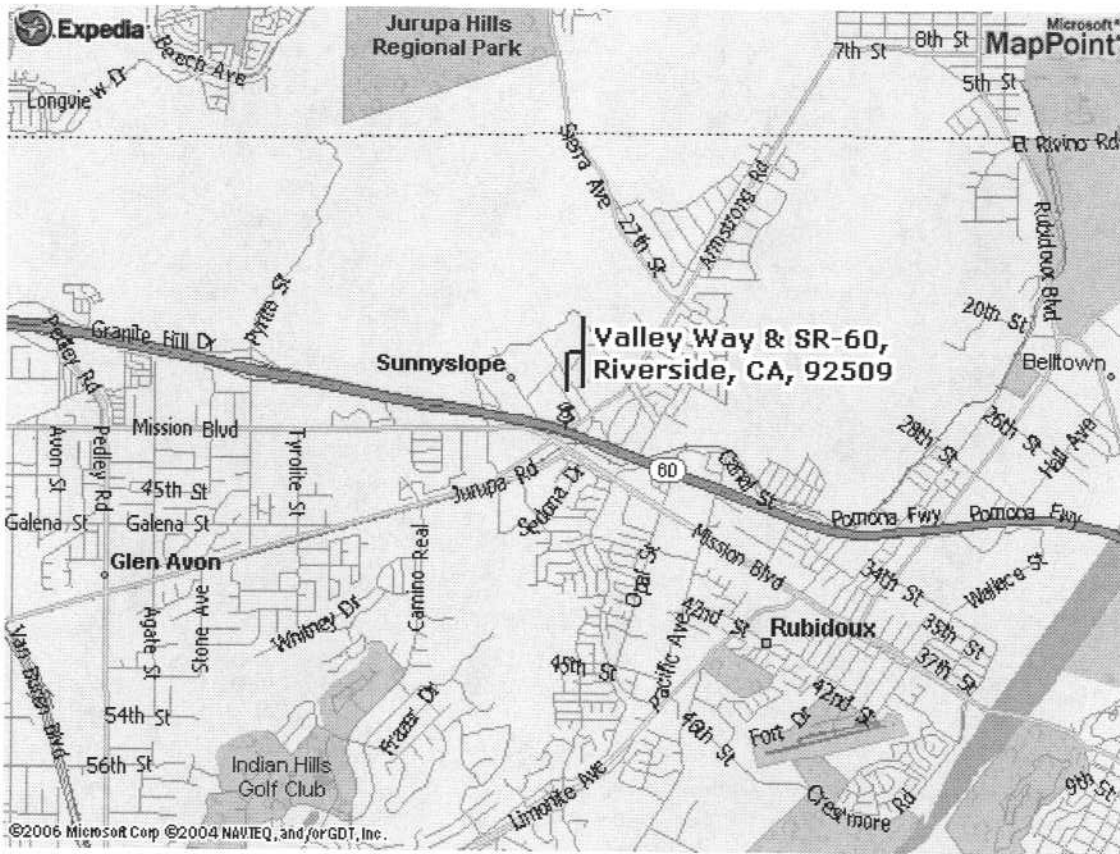

The submitted agreement provides for the positive location of underground gas lines, as required by the State of California's Policy on High and Low Risk Underground Facilities. Inasmuch as the work is required due to a freeway improvement project, the County is required to comply with the State of California's Master Agreement with the Southern California Gas Company dated November 24, 1964 which requires that the cost for the work be shared equally.

The Transportation Department has prepared the submitted agreement in accordance with State of California requirements, inasmuch as the County is acting as an agent of the State on this project. The agreement is consistent with the project requirements, and has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.
