SUBJECT: Consolidation of Special Elections

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve consolidation of special school district elections with the June 6, 2006 Consolidated Direct Primary Election and authorize the Registrar of Voters to conduct subject elections for the Romoland School District, the Beaumont Unified School District, the Hemet Unified School District, the Nuview Union School District, the Murrieta Valley Unified School District, the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District and the Banning Unified School District pursuant to their respective resolutions.

BACKGROUND: California Elections Code § 10403 allows jurisdictions to request consolidation of special elections by submitting a resolution to the Board of Supervisors not later than the 88th day before the June 6, 2006 Consolidated Direct Primary Election. The Romoland School District, the Beaumont Unified School, the Hemet Unified School District, the Nuview Union School District, the Murrieta Valley Unified School District, the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District and the Banning Unified School District have complied with this requirement and request consolidation of their special elections. The contests and measures to be placed on the ballot are attached as Exhibit A.

The department has the resources to consolidate these elections concurrently with this year's Consolidated Direct Primary Election. The school districts will reimburse the department based on associated direct costs for each jurisdiction.
