SUBJECT: Standard Agreement No. 06-0035 Regarding the Petroleum Product Sampling and the Weighmaster Enforcement Programs.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve Standard Agreement No. 06-0035 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture in the amount of \$27,150 for FY 06/07 and
- 2) Authorize the chairman to sign the agreement

BACKGROUND: This agreement is renewed yearly and provides for county reimbursement for all costs associated with these two programs. The Petroleum Product Sampling program involves conducting quality control inspections of businesses that sell various petroleum products and for sampling of petroleum products to determine compliance with the California Business and Professions Code. The Weighmaster Enforcement Program involves conducting undercover purchases/sales at licensed weighmaster locations, as well as conducting verification inspections on common tare weights. Revenue from this source was included in the Agricultural Commissioner's FY 06/07 budget request. The contract was approved as to form by County Counsel.
