SUBJECT: Fire Engine Transfer – 1987 Spartan Gladiator Vin# 1S9HT6DO9HC185139

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the transfer of ownership of a 1987 Spartan Gladiator Type Engine to the City of Indian Wells.

BACKGROUND: The Fire Department, as part of our on-going engine replacement program, is disposing this surveyed engine and requests ownership be transferred to the City of Indian Wells. The City of Indian Wells requested the transfer to support their sponsorship of the Log Hill Volunteer Fire District located in the state of Colorado. The Log Hill volunteers provide countywide fire suppression in all areas of Ouray County not covered by a fire district. This represents approximately 150 square miles of unincorporated area that includes residential, ranch, state and federal forestlands. This engine will replace a 1972 GMC mini-pumper previously donated by the City of Banning. City of Indian Wells will be responsible for the transfer of the fire engine from the Riverside County Fire Department to the Log Hill Volunteer unit.
