**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Sixth Amendment to the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and the Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health for Medical Care, Oral Health Care and Pharmacy Services (Contract 04-152 A-6).

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**BACKGROUND:** The Ryan White CARE Act (RWCA) was enacted in 1990 to provide federal funding for comprehensive health and social services for persons living with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV).

As the payer of last resort, the RWCA is invaluable in filling the gaps in health care for people living with HIV/AIDS. The CARE Act has enabled people living with HIV/AIDS to live longer through the provision of a safety net of HIV care services, including medical and dental care and provisions for HIV medications. These funds will be used to continue HIV medical, dental, and pharmacy services at the Riverside Neighborhood Health Clinic and Riverside County Regional Medical Center.

The Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved Amendments A-1 and A-2 to the Agreement with the County of San Bernardino on May 3, 2005, Item 3.5 for the performance period of March, 1 2004 through February 28, 2005 in the amount of \$101,954. Amendment A-3 was approved on September 13, 2005 allowed for an adjustment to Section V. Fiscal Provisions, increasing funds from \$101,954 to \$525,563 for F/Y 05/06 and extended the performance period from March 1, 2005 through February 28, 2006. The Fourth and Fifth Amendments to the Agreement allowed for an adjustment to Section V. Fiscal Provisions, increasing funds from \$525,563 to \$974,815 for F/Y 05/06.

Approval of this amendment will augment this contract with San Bernardino Department of Public Health. The additional funds will be used to perform a comprehensive Ambulatory/Outpatient Medical Care study and provide Oral Health services to an additional 17 clients. The additional funds became available due to the Federal Government approving the carryover of unspent funds from the previous funding year.

**JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY:** The Department of Public Health recently received this agreement from San Bernardino County. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently submitted through the County's approval process.
