BACKGROUND: In 1998, the Department of Mental Health entered into an operational agreement with the Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center to work in a collaborative effort to provide assistance to sexual assault survivors and their families.

SUBJECT: Approval of the Operational Agreement between Riverside County Department of Mental Health and the Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center.

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The Rape Crisis Center was established in 1973 and is a grass roots, non-profit organization committed to providing support and community education to achieve awareness and prevention of sexual assault. The center provides services to male and female clients of all ages in all communities of Riverside County.

The Operational Agreement between the Rape Crisis Center and DOMH outlines the roles and responsibilities of each agency. The Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center will provide the following services to persons referred by DOMH: 24 hour crisis intervention, advocacy and accompaniment for survivors and their families, follow-up services, short term counseling, survivor groups, information and referral and community education.

This agreement is the understanding that the two agencies agree to a reciprocal exchange of personnel for volunteer and staff training, or other projects where specific expertise would enhance program effectiveness. The agencies will also service as resources for one another and share information in order to provide the best possible service to sexual assault survivors.

Period of Performance

The Department is asking the Board to approve the renewal of the operational agreement from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2010. No county funds are required.
