BACKGROUND:

On September 27, 2005, your Honorable Board approved a Form 11 (Agenda item 3.3b) authorizing the extension of the existing contracts for the Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment (CAPIT) and Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) Agreements through June 30, 2006. Family Services of the Desert (FSD) is funded under both programs to provide an array of services, such as parenting education classes, in-home visits, counseling and conflict resolution, caregiver support, and family/caregiver mediation throughout the underserved communities in the Coachella Valley and Blythe. FSD has requested a cash advance through these contracts due to limited cash reserves.

After further discussion with FSD it has been determined that there is a need to modify the advance language in the FY 2005/06 agreement.

At this time we are requesting that your Honorable Board approve the Amendment to the FSD Agreements and allow the advance of funds to be repaid from the FY 2006/07 funding agreements in twelve (12) monthly payments, beginning with the 1st claim for payment submitted by the contractor for the month of July, 2006, and continuing until the entire balance of the advance is recaptured by June 30, 2007.

There is no cost to the County for these services.
