SUBJECT: Approval and Ratification of Professional Service Agreements for the Family Resource Centers in Riverside County

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute the Professional Services Agreements listed in Attachment "A" for the Family Resource Centers located in Rubidoux, Perris, Desert Hot Springs, and Mecca for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 using the template contract attached hereto, and all other ministerial agreements; and
2. Authorize the County Department heads of CHA, including the Department of Public Health, to execute the Professional Services Agreements on behalf of the Department; and
3. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the Agreements.

BACKGROUND:

The goal of Family Resource Centers (FRCs) is to develop healthy families who live in healthy communities. FRCs function as a hub of community services designed to improve family life, particularly for overburdened or disadvantaged families and children. FRCs engage families in their own problem solving process which results in psychological, social, and economic self-sufficiency. They utilize community building strategies which involve principles of family support, resident involvement, development of public/private partnerships, and shared accountability.

BACKGROUND (continued):

There are four FRCs located in the communities of Rubidoux, Perris, Desert Hot Springs, and Mecca. These Centers house the Community Service Providers offering services listed in the attached Agreements.

The Community Service Providers must be either a public agency or a private non-profit agency with 501(c)(3) tax exempt status. The Providers must be able to provide one of the following core services:

- Parenting Skills
- Self-Sufficiency
- Community Action
- Child Abuse Prevention Services
- Resource Development, Information & Referral Services
- Education and Literacy
- Life Skills

DPSS requests approval of the Community Service Provider agreements listed in Attachment A.

DPSS requests approval of the use of the contract template, attached hereto as Attachment B, for all FRC agreements authorized pursuant to this Form 11. Since each contract may not be providing all the core services listed above, which are also included in section III A 1 of the contract template, the specific contracts may include one or more of those core services as applicable.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

No County funds are required. The State Family Preservation Allocation will continue to fund the facility leases for the four FRCs.
