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RECOMMENDED MOTION (CONTINUED):

3) Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the terms of the Agreements.

BACKGROUND:

On February 1, 2006 Riverside County Purchasing and Fleet Services released Request for Proposals for the CAPIT Program (PUARC-802), PSSF Program (PUARC-803), and Differential Response (PUARC-805). The RFPs closed on March 1, 2006 with 44 proposals submitted from 29 organizations.

As a result of the RFPs, 17 organizations were recommended to receive funding. On May 16, 2006, (Agenda #3.20), your Honorable Board approved the FY06/07 CAPIT & PSSF Funding Recommendations. Of the 27 resulting agreements, 6 exceeded the Purchasing Agent's authority, and are being submitted to your Honorable Board for signature. The maximum annual amount for each agreement is as follows:
