SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2006-258 for a Mid-Block Crosswalk on Orange Street, Eastvale area.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution No. 2006-258 for a Mid-Block Crosswalk on Orange Street in the Eastvale area, as described in the attached resolution.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department has received a request from the Corona-Norco Unified School District requesting the installation of a mid-block crosswalk on Orange Street to better channelize student pedestrians crossing the street between the new Elementary School on the north side of Orange Street, and the new Middle School on the south side of Orange Street, west of Cleveland Avenue.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the school sites, and determined that a marked crosswalk will better channelize student pedestrians to a specific location for orderly crossing of Orange Street. Appropriate school zone/school crosswalk signing and markings will be installed. The Corona-Norco Unified School District also plans to fund a crossing guard at this crosswalk.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of this proposed mid-block crosswalk.

The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed mid-block crosswalk.

County Counsel has approved the resolution.

16 crossing.

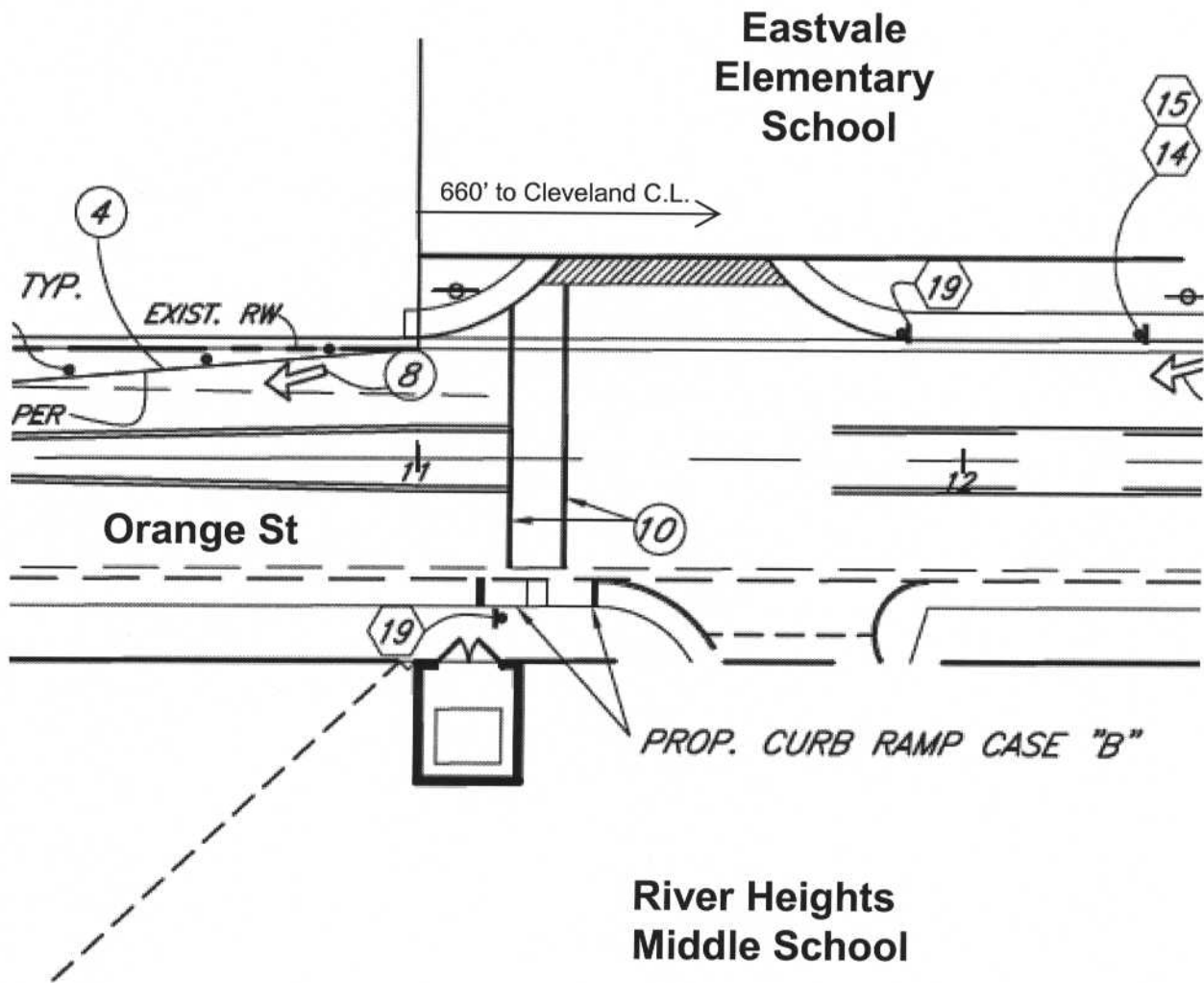
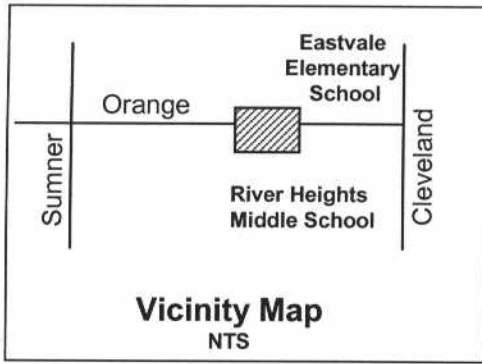
