**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

The Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health has been awarded funding in the amount of \$105,498 from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission to continue the VaxTrack Immunization Registry program throughout Riverside County as part of a 6 month contract extension.

The VaxTrack Immunization Registry is one of nine regional immunization registries in California. VaxTrack was established in July 2000 as an interagency project with the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health. The goal of the Immunization Registry Program is to improve the health of the community by assuring that all children receive appropriate preventive services, particularly age-appropriate immunizations. VaxTrack links immunization providers, including public and private medical care providers, managed care organizations, hospital-based health delivery systems and other agencies, such as schools, foster care, and WIC, within each of the participating counties to a central database for the coordinated registry of immunization information on children.

To date, VaxTrack has over 381 participating providers. The program has achieved 100% public provider participation and more than 60% private provider participation in Riverside County. More than 160 eligible schools and day care providers are currently enrolled in VaxTrack. As of May 17, 2006, almost 177,000 children in Riverside County had immunizations recorded in the registry.
