RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Agreement No. 07-11 OP between Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health, and the Riverside County Children & Families Commission in the amount of \$117,432 for the performance period of July 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four (4) copies of the Agreement on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Children and Families Commission has awarded Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health continued funding in the amount of \$117,432 to provide second-hand smoke education and tobacco cessation counseling to parents of children aged 0-5 years through December 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND:

The Tobacco Free Families Program was developed with grant funding from the Commission in previous years, and provides in-home tobacco education and cessation services to eligible family members. The program has been successful in reducing second-hand smoke exposure to children of past program enrollees.
