Subject: Ratify the acceptance of Community Grants and an Educational Grant totaling \$23,250 to support The Fifth California Inter-County Annual Hepatitis C Task Force Conference.

BACKGROUND: (Continued).

In 2005, over 1,600 cases of hepatitis C were reported in Riverside County. It is important for clinicians to be updated on the medical management of the disease. In addition, there needs to be heightened awareness of policy makers of the significant impact of HCV disease on the healthcare infrastructure and the lives of infected individuals. Community grants were provided to support The Fifth California Inter-County Annual Hepatitis C Task Force Conference.

Funds received are to support the 2 day conference held in Riverside, California on April 7th and 8th, 2006. Funds include Community Grants in amount of \$10,000 from the California Wellness Foundation, \$1,000 from Home Access Health Corporation, \$2,000 from GlaxoSmithKline, \$250 from Loma Linda University Medical Center, \$2,500 from Valeant Pharmaceuticals \$2,500 from California Hepatitis C Task Force (for Roche Laboratories Inc.), and the Educational Grant is in the amount of \$5,000 from Schering Corporation.
