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**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—RIVERSIDE COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH**

BACKGROUND:

On July 13, 2004, (Agenda Item 3.37), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development which included the Desert Outreach program operated through an MOU between the Department of Mental Health and DPSS to provide outreach to homeless individuals in Mid-County and Desert Regions who are severely and persistently mentally ill.

While the original project ended on January 31, 2006, HUD executed the attached renewal grant agreement on May 9, 2006. DPSS received this grant agreement on May 12, 2006. This renewal grant is retroactive because of staffing shortages in the Los Angeles HUD Field Office.

Department of Mental Health's outreach project goal is to serve 500 homeless individuals each year. During the original project from December 31, 2003 through January 31, 2006, Department of Mental Health served 555 individuals per year.

DPSS will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Department of Mental Health to operate the Desert Outreach supportive housing program.
