**BACKGROUND:** This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the Eastvale Flood Control facilities are to be constructed by the County and inspected, operated and maintained by the County and the District.

Upon completion of the construction of the project, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drains. The County will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the associated catch basins and laterals located within its rights of way.
