**SUBJECT:** Construction of Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter, and Road Improvements on Conning Street from Mission Boulevard to Ben Nevis Boulevard, Glen Avon area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board accept the bid of Sully Miller Contracting Company of Anaheim, CA in the amount of \$474,000.00 for the base bid schedule of work. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents. Amend the Transportation Improvement Program's project budget as proposed on Attachment "A".

**BACKGROUND:** By Minute Order dated April 18, 2006 (agenda item 3.22) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter, and road improvements on Conning Street from Mission Boulevard to Ben Nevis Boulevard, in the Glen Avon area of Riverside County. The bid documents included an alternate bid schedule for the relocation of conflicting utilities that are owned by the Jurupa Community Services District. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, May 10, 2006. Eight bids were

received. The lowest and best bid was submitted by Sully-Miller Contracting Company in the amount of \$516,500.00 for all schedules of work, which is the basis for the determination of the low bid.

The Jurupa Community Services District has informed the Transportation Department that they do not want their items of work performed by the County's contractor due to the high bid price submitted by Sully-Miller Contracting Company for Alternate Bid Schedule no. 1, and that the water district will perform the necessary relocations with their own forces. Therefore, the recommendation of the Transportation Department is to award only the base bid items of work.

The bid received from Sully-Miller Contracting Company in the amount of \$474,000.00 for the base bid items of work, which is the County's portion, is \$17,150.00 (3.5%) below the Engineer's estimate for the base bid items of work.

The construction of sidewalk and curb and gutter is needed to improve pedestrian access to Mission Bell Elementary School which is located on Conning Street between Mission Boulevard and Ben Nevis Boulevard. The pavement resurfacing is needed due to poor pavement conditions.

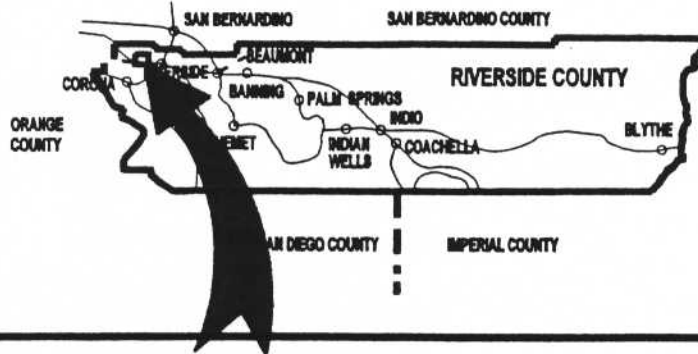
The Transportation Department currently has a funding agreement with the Redevelopment Agency in the amount of \$101,000 for the design of the project. A separate funding agreement between the County and the Redevelopment Agency, which provides for the additional required construction funds, was approved by the Board of Supervisors by Minute Order dated June 6, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.18).

The State of California funds available for the project are monies obtained through Statewide competition in the Safe Route to Schools program.

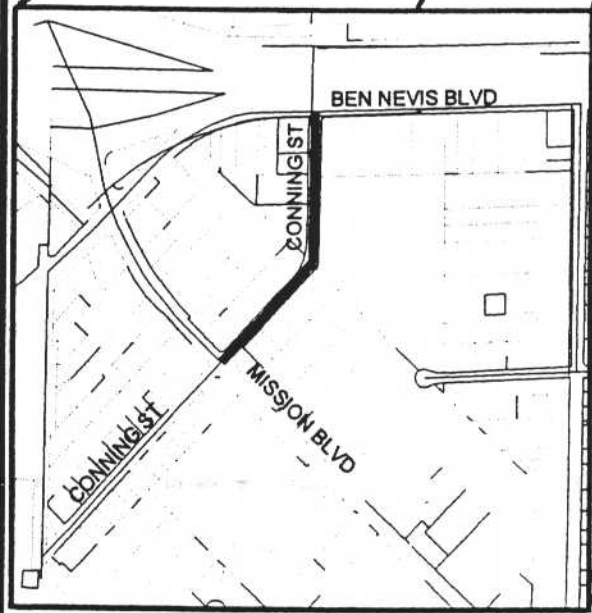
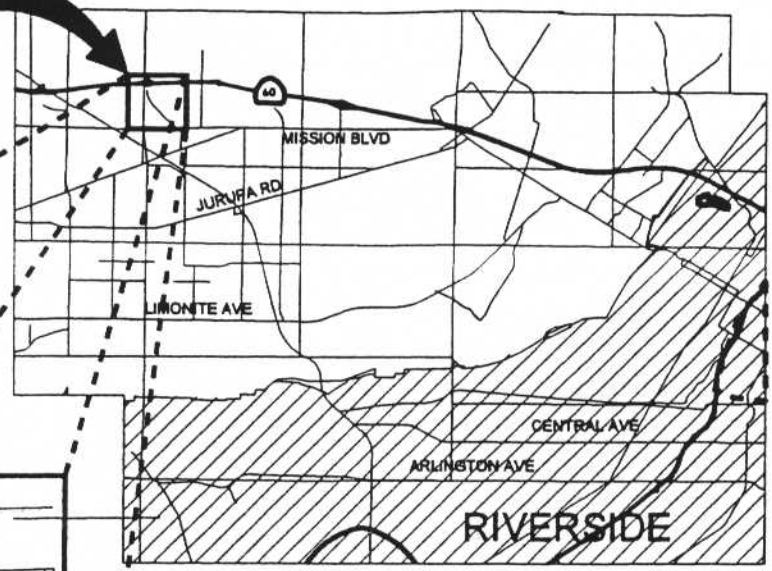
