Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, August 16, 2006, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: Portions of Scott Road were severely damaged during the 2004 / 2005 storm season, and repair is necessary within the following limits:

1. Antelope Road to Little Reb Place
2. Lindenberger Road to Ashford Lane
