BACKGROUND continued:

The Transportation Department will administer the construction contract, grant the District the necessary rights to construct, operate and maintain the project within County road right of way, and assume responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the project's associated catch basins and laterals located within County road right of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form. A companion item appears on the Transportation Department's agenda this same date.

FINANCIAL:

The District is contributing \$789,495 toward the construction of the drainage improvements. Sufficient funds are available in the District's Zone 2 construction budget for FY 2005-06.
