SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement with City of Hemet

BACKGROUND continued:

The Riverside County Department of Animal Services has been providing Field Services for the City of Hemet since August 1, 2003 and provides a wide range of animal control activities for the purpose of safeguarding the City of Hemet's domestic and wild animals, promoting the humane treatment of animals and enforcing the City of Hemet's Ordinances and State laws relating to animal control.

The City of Hemet animals are housed at Ramona Humane Society, with the County being the conduit through which these animals are placed there. Due to the increase in animal intakes this year the cost has increased for shelter services.

The \$170,514 funding has been included in the Fiscal Year 06/07 budget which was approved by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors on June 27, 2006.
