BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is collaborating with Jurupa Unified School District on the Healthy Children Connection project. The program promotes early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children five years of age and under. Jurupa Unified School District offers services to clients in District 2 with funding through First 5 Riverside in the amount of \$81,140 for FY 05/06 and \$40,570 for FY 06/07.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level. Exhibits A and Attachment A have been modified and Attachment D has been added for the period January 1, 2006 – December 31, 2006 to reflect changes in the Scope of Work at the request of First 5 Riverside.
