SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution #2006-283 Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to Submit a Grant Application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution #2006-283, which authorizes the Sheriff to sign and submit a grant application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation for \$210,000 to continue off-highway vehicle (OHV) law enforcement efforts in Riverside County and expand enforcement by targeting sites in the unincorporated areas of all five Supervisorial Districts.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Parks and Recreation is currently accepting grant applications for its Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program. On September 10, 2002 (3.32), the Board accepted two Project Agreements with the Department for a County off-highway motor vehicle enforcement program. Christened the Riverside Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program (R.O.V.E.), this innovative and effective program has put Deputies on all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) to enforce laws concerning illegal off-highway driving, dumping, driving under the influence and environmental destruction. The use of ATVs versus pursuits off-highway in black and white units also has substantially increased officer safety. The Board accepted and approved project grant agreements to continue this effort for a second year on April 27, 2004 (3.18), and for a third year on July 12, 2005 (3.58).

The current application will begin Phase IV of the Sheriff's county-wide effort by expanding enforcement efforts in all five Supervisorial Districts with a proposed start date of February 2007. The application requests \$210,000 to support Deputy Sheriff overtime and purchase equipment for continued and expanded patrols in problematic areas.

The grant application includes a 25% County match in the amount of \$63,529. The Department proposes contributing an in-kind match of \$42,042 for the project's Deputy overtime, and a \$21,487 cash match for equipment purchases. All local match contributions will come from the Department's status quo budget. Any grant awarded will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for review and approval.

During the development of this fourth phase of the county-wide project, the Sheriff requested public comment via a posting on the Department's web site and through mailings to interested individuals.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR STATE OF
CALIFORNIA OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS: LAW
ENFORCEMENT AND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Act of 2003 as amended, which provides funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquisition projects, conservation projects, development projects, equipment purchases, facilities operation and maintenance projects, law enforcement projects, OHV safety and/or education program projects, planning projects, restoration and/or repair projects, specific research projects. And trail maintenance projects for off-highway vehicle recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division within the California Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility to administer the program; and

WHEREAS, procedures established by the California Department of Parks and Recreation require the Applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the application to apply for Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant funds; and

1 WHEREAS, this project appears on, or is in conformance with Riverside County's
2 adopted general or master plan and is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions
3 immediately surrounding the project;

5 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Board of
6 Supervisors hereby:

- 7 • Approves the Sheriff's Department's filing of an application for an Off-
8 Highway Vehicle Grant that will and expand the Riverside Off-Highway
9 Vehicle Enforcement (R.O.V.E.) Program (Phase IV) to provide off-
10 highway law enforcement in all five Supervisorial Districts;
- 11 • Certifies that Riverside County understands its legal obligations to the
12 State upon approval of the grant; and
- 13 • Certifies that equipment acquired under the grant will be well maintained
14 during its useful life; and
- 15 • Certifies that Riverside County will implement the project with diligence
16 once funds are available and the Applicant has reviewed, understands,
17 and agrees with the Project Agreement; and
- 18 • Certifies that Riverside County will provide the required matching funds;
19 and
- 20 • Certifies that the public and adjacent property owners have been notified
21 of this project (as applicable); and
- 22 • Appoints Sheriff Bob Doyle as agent to conduct all negotiations and
23 execute and submit all required documents, including but not necessarily
