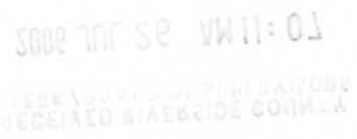

**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT RENEWAL GRANT AGREEMENT—RIVERSIDE
COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH**

BACKGROUND:

On June 7, 2005, (Agenda Item 3.60), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development which included the Women's Permanent Supportive Housing Project operated through an MOU between the Department of Mental Health and DPSS to provide permanent housing for women with mental illness. The Department of Mental Health's goal for this project is to serve 6 individuals each year.

The original project will expire on November 30, 2006. HUD executed the attached renewal grant agreement on May 22, 2006. DPSS received this grant agreement on May 26, 2006.

DPSS will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Mental Health to operate the Women's Permanent Supportive Housing Project.
