Due to the increasing demand for baseball fields and the infrequent use of the existing soccer field, Big League Dreams determined it would be beneficial to convert the existing field into two baseball diamonds in order to increase the utilization of the facility by the public and increase the number of fields available for local leagues. The Agency expects the improvements to increase gross annual facility revenue by approximately \$200,000 in the first year of operation and \$341,000 by the fifth year.

The Redevelopment Agency solicited bids for the conversion of existing underutilized soccer fields to baseball diamonds. Three bids were received and opened by the Clerk of the Board.

After detailed review, Agency staff recommends that the Board award the contract to the lowest qualified and responsive bidder, Genesis Paving & Landscaping, Inc. in the amount of \$1,105,250 and approve the project budget as follows:
