SUBJECT: Second District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds to Rubidoux High School Delta Alliance Corps;
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

Increase Appropriations:

Decrease Board Designation:

10000-1000100000-320135 Community Improvement \$15,000.00

BACKGROUND: This contribution will be used to purchase a field show director's platform as well as some much needed percussion equipment replacements, as most of the Delta Alliance Corp's percussion equipment is well over 20 years old.

The Rubidoux High School Delta Alliance Corps has received worldwide recognition by being the first marching band to win back-to-back Fiesta Bowl National Grand Championships in 2000 and 2001. The DAC has also participated as the lead unit in the 62nd Annual Hollywood Christmas Parade, was seen in the Philadelphia Freedom 4th of July parade, and in addition to local performances, the Delta Alliance Corps has toured the east coast, stopping to perform at locations such as Boston and New York City, culminating with a command performance at the White House. Performance sites abroad include a tour through the United Kingdom, Germany, Switzerland and Austria, where the DAC were the official band for the State of California for Austria's millennium celebrations.
