SUBJECT: Reappointment of Riverside County Public Member to the Inland Empire Health Plan Board (IEHP), and the IEHP Health Access Governing Boards


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board take the following action:

1. Re-appoint Kay Cenicerros to the public member position for Riverside County on the Inland Empire Health Plan Governing Board.
2. Re-appoint Kay Cenicerros to the public member position for Riverside County on the IEHP Health Access Governing Board.

BACKGROUND: The Inland Empire Health Plan was established as a Joint Powers Authority with San Bernardino County in 1994. Inland Empire Health Plan is the administrative body for the managed health care program for Medi-Cal members in the two county region.

IEHP Health Access was established as a Joint Powers Authority with San Bernardino in 2005. IEHP Health Access is the administrative body for the managed health care program for the non-Medi-Cal members who were formerly in the Inland Empire Health Plan.

Subject: Reappointment of Riverside County Public Member to the Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP), and the IEHP Health Access Governing Boards

Background: [Continued]

The JPA Agreements of both Inland Empire Health Plan and IEHP Health Access require that this Board appoint a public member to both governing boards. Appointment of a public member to the IEHP Governing Board will automatically result in the same appointment to the IEHP Health Access Governing Board.

Consequently, the Governing Boards of Inland Empire Health Plan and IEHP Health Access are the same.

Ms. Kay Cenicerros was appointed to the IEHP Governing Board as the public member from Riverside County in 2002, and has served as such for the past two years.

Ms. Cenicerros was appointed as a governing board member of IEHP Health Access when it was established in 2005.

Re-appointment of Ms. Cenicerros will ensure that the interests of Riverside County remain fully represented on these important boards. If re-appointed, Ms. Cenicerros' term would be for two years on both governing boards.
