

SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2006- 382 : Mesa Verde Community Council

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve Resolution No. 2006-382, establishing the Mesa Verde Community Council and tasking the newly-created council with the duties of the County Service Area 122 Advisory Committee. The boundaries of the new Community Council shall be conterminous with the existing CSA.

BACKGROUND: Community Councils have been established in many unincorporated communities in eastern Riverside County, and have been very successful in providing input to the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern to the residents.

The CSA 122 Advisory Committee is the only sounding board for residents of the community, and, as a result, the Advisory Committee is often asked by residents to intervene on a variety of issues, such as code enforcement complaints, graffiti, law enforcement, truck parking, etc. It is more appropriate, therefore, that the community be represented by a Community Council, and that the new Council execute the duties of the CSA 122 Advisory Committee.
