SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT CA16B308001, AMENDMENT #1 -
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SOCIAL SERVICES

BACKGROUND:

On July 1, 2003, (Agenda Item 3.49), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included funding to operate a Safe Haven supportive housing project to serve the "most often visible" and "hardest to reach" homeless persons with severe mental illness within the City of Riverside.

As a result of a Request for Proposal, the Board entered into an agreement with IURD September 27, 2005 (Agenda # 3.40) to operate the Safe Haven Project. IURD later informed DPSS that because it was restructuring, it would no longer have the capability to operate the Safe Haven Project.

On May 9, 2006 HUD executed Grant Amendment #1, which extended the Grant term to January 1, 2008, effective May 9, 2006. This extension allows the new Project Sponsor, Riverside County Department of Mental Health, to apply for renewal of the grant in the 2007 HUD Super NOFA competition. DPSS received the Grant Agreement on July 10, 2006, which we are forwarding to your Board for approval. The Director of DPSS will later enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Mental Health to run the Supportive Housing Program.
