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SUBJECT: FAMILY PRESERVATION COURT SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR 2006/2007 FISCAL YEAR .

BACKGROUND:

On December 6, 2005, (Agenda #3.18), the Board entered into an agreement on behalf of DPSS with Mental Health Systems to provide Family Preservation Court Services for East Indio, Southwest County, and the Riverside Metro area. This agreement expanded DPSS and Family Court goals to enhance the services of the Family Preservation Court for families by increasing the ability of the Dependency Court to provide drug treatment as an alternative to loss of child custody. Additionally, it provides for a rigorous data collection and outcome evaluation process to inform local and state governance about the efficacy and cost savings associated with the Family Preservation Court program and to improve operations.

This agreement included provisions for two one-year renewals. Based on the positive response to the program to date, we are requesting that the Board exercise the option to renew the agreement for FY 06/07. As a result of this agreement, up to 120 participants are projected to be served annually.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The annual cost to the County for these services will be \$40,240.
