2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign any ministerial amendments with MFI Recovery Center, not to exceed the maximum amount of the Agreement (\$150,000); and
3. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the Agreement with MFI Recovery Center.

SUBJECT: SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR 2006/2007 FISCAL YEAR – MFI RECOVERY CENTER

BACKGROUND:

Objectives of the Substance Abuse Treatment Services program are to provide residential, outpatient, and detoxification drug treatment services to DPSS child protective services clients in Riverside County. These services provided by MFI are essential for clients who require intensive substance abuse treatment as quickly as possible to assist with reunification efforts.

PRICE REASONABLENESS:

On April 10, 2006, the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) issued a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit proposals for Substance Abuse Treatment Services. The RFP was sent to 17 bidders and advertised on the internet. MFI Recovery Center and Perris Valley Recovery were the only organizations submitting proposals under the RFP with prices for out patient services ranging from \$28 to \$60. MFI was the only responder to bid on the residential and detoxification services at \$65 and \$95 per day respectively. Based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP, MFI Recovery Center, at \$28 per hour for outpatient services, was determined to be the lowest cost and most responsive and responsible bidder and is recommended to receive the contract award.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The annual cost to the County for these services will be \$45,000.
