BACKGROUND:

In 2005 the Rummond Senior Center, located in Thermal, was operated by the Office on Aging as part of the CAP Riverside Cool Center Program. Office on Aging's funding only allowed the cool center to be open from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Supervisor Wilson's Office asked the Office on Aging to secure funding to hire a temporary county employee (TAP) to keep the center open everyday between 1:00 – 5:00 p.m., the hottest time of the day. The center is the only accessible facility in the Thermal area that can accommodate elderly residents and others who do not have transportation to travel to a cooling site located further away. The cool center was activated for 41 days and provided relief to 580 individuals.

The Office on Aging requested CAP Riverside to seek special funding to operate the cool center in 2006. CAP Riverside recognizes that the health needs of this most vulnerable population are not being met during extreme summer temperatures and feels that there is significant circumstances to warrant keeping this cool center open. Regional Access Project Foundation awarded \$3,500 to CAP Riverside to hire a TAP employee to operate the Rummond Senior Center as a cool center from July 1, 2006 through September 30, 2006, Monday through Friday, 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The Director of DPSS-CAP Riverside requests that the Board approve the attached Agreement #DC3093-00 between the Regional Access Project Foundation and DPSS-CAP Riverside, for the term June 2006 to October 31, 2006 in the amount of \$3,500.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required.
