**SUBJECT:** Resolution No. 2006-373 Authorizing Execution of Documents to Facilitate Closure Construction of the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

Adopt Resolution 2006-373 authorizing the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the Waste Management Department to sign documents necessary to facilitate closure construction at the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill.

**BACKGROUND:** The Department is close to obtaining final regulatory approvals of the Final Closure and Post-Closure Maintenance Plan (FCPCMP) for the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill, which ceased accepting waste in December of 2004. A key component of the FCPCMP soil cover consists of importing clay material to blend with onsite material, which allows for a more environmentally protective yet thinner (and therefore less costly) cap over the in-place waste. The Department has located a clay borrow source in the vicinity of the Edom Hill landfill that is located on property controlled by the Federal Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), with a Coachella Valley Water District (CVWD) easement across a portion of it. The Department has worked with the BOR to develop a Permit for Removal of Clay Material (also known as a "Free Use Permit") to access and obtain clay material at no cost to the Department, as allowed for by 43 CRF §429.6 (c) (3). The BOR requires that a resolution, authorizing signature of the Permit for Removal of Clay Material, be obtained from our governing board prior to approval of the permit. Resolution 2006-373 (attached) authorizing the Department to execute agreements to obtain clay material has been prepared. Staff and legal counsel have reviewed the permit and are recommending that the Board authorize the resolution so that the Department may sign the permit and any future documents of this nature, such as right of entry agreements, that will facilitate acquisition of clay material from the BOR and closure construction at the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS TO FACILITATE  
CLOSURE CONSTRUCTION OF THE EDM HILL SANITARY LANDFILL**

**WHEREAS**, the Riverside County Waste Management Department is the County Department responsible for carrying out the permitting, expansion, daily operation and closure of publicly owned and operated sanitary landfills within Riverside County; and

**WHEREAS**, certain access agreements, excavation permits and other documents related to the closure of the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill are required from Federal, State and Local agencies to adequately close the site in accordance with State and Federal regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) controls property in the vicinity of the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill that contains clay material suitable for inclusion in the Edom Hill Final Cover design and the BOR is authorized to allow the County of Riverside use of the material pursuant to 43 CRF §429.6;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and empowers the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the Waste Management Department to execute in the name of the County of Riverside the necessary permit and any related documents necessary to provide access to and removal of clay material from the property controlled by Federal Bureau of Reclamation for use in the closure of the Edom Hill Landfill.
