SUBJECT: Consultant Agreement for providing Quality Assurance and Quality Control Professional Services during the construction of the Waste Recycle Park Phase 1 Development Project at Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the Consultant Agreement with Advanced Earth Sciences to provide Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QA/QC) services during the construction of the Waste Recycle Park (WRP) Phase 1 Development Project at Lamb Canyon Landfill, and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Waste Management Department.

BACKGROUND: On May 23, 2006 the Board approved the contract documents to construct the WRP at Lamb Canyon Landfill. In order to comply with the applicable Federal, State, and local regulations and standards, QA/QC services related to this construction project need to be provided. The Department does not have personnel that are available to perform these services nor the adequate equipment and facilities to perform the work; therefore, a third-party consultant is required.

The scope of services requires the consultant to provide construction observation and field testing, laboratory testing, and consultant must prepare a final construction quality assurance report. (Continued)

In response to a Department Request for Proposal, four proposals were received from consultants qualified in this field. The cost range of these proposals varied from \$36,855 to \$94,964 (refer to attached summary). These proposals were carefully reviewed by the Department's engineering staff, and based on that review, Advanced Earth Sciences (AES) was found to be the most technically sound and the most responsive to the RFP. AES's proposal came in at a total cost of \$36,855 - an amount determined by the staff to be reasonable considering the required scope of work.

This Project is budgeted for fiscal year 06-07 in Fund 40200, Department ID - 4500100000.
