**SUBJECT:** Software Maintenance and Support Select Subscription - Bentley Systems, Incorporated

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board:

1. Approve the sole source software maintenance and support invoice between Waste Management Department and Bentley Systems Incorporated (Attachment A).
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to exercise the options to renew annually for up to 5 one year Periods.
3. Direct the Purchasing Department to issue a purchase order on behalf of Waste Management Department.

**BACKGROUND:** The Waste Management Department staff has been utilizing computer aided design and drafting (CADD), plotting and civil engineering software from Bentley Systems, Incorporated for over 11 years and this software is the primary tool for the engineers and technicians. The software products streamline the staff's daily work flow as they design landfill contours, produce records for survey, generate topographical maps and subsequently plot these to paper maps. In order to continue receiving software upgrades and patches, we need to renew our Select Subscription with Bentley Systems for FY 2006-07.

The Select Subscription supports 5 programs with a total of 38 licenses. Through the Select Subscription, we will continue to receive technical assistance for software malfunctions or for assistance with new features either through e-mail, telephone or online. Additionally, through the Select Subscription, we can make use of the license pooling feature so that the software can be installed on more workstations without having to purchase more licenses.

This is a sole source purchase since the software is proprietary to Bentley Systems, Incorporated and no other supplier provides software upgrades, license renewals and technical support for Microstation, InRoads Survey, Storm and Sanitary software.

WMD requests authority to renew the subscription with Bentley on an annual basis for up to five years without returning to the Board. This action would streamline the department's ability to pay the vendor and secure the critical computer programming necessary for the Department engineering staff. Since the programs are proprietary, it would remain a sole source vendor.

**PRICE REASONABLENESS:** The pricing offered the County is based on The California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) #3-01-70-1198B. CMAS contracts are awarded by the state Department of General Services and insure that the pricing offered is the lowest price offered any state and local government. CMAS pricing is on file with California Board of Equalization for Bentley Systems Inc. The CMAS pricing insures that the cost of the Bentley Select Subscription is fair and reasonable.

**FINANCIAL:**

Funds for the software maintenance and support contract are included in the Waste Management Department's IT budget for FY 2006-07.
