
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Third Amendment to the Healthy Families Memorandum of Understanding between the Inland Empire Health Plan and the Riverside County Community Health Agency; The Third Amendment of this MOU, notwithstanding the date of execution, will be effective as of July 1, 2004, and shall continue in effect through June 30, 2005. Thereafter, the term of the MOU shall automatically be extended up to a maximum of four (4) successive one (1) year term(s) unless terminated. The renewal of this MOU is required on or before June 30, 2009, unless terminated;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to execute said Amendment on behalf of the County; and
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) signed copy and return 3 copies to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administrator.

SUBJECT: Approval of the Third Amendment to the Healthy Families Memorandum of Understanding between Inland Empire Health Plan and Riverside County Community Health Agency

BACKGROUND continued: Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is a participant in California's Healthy Families Program. This Memorandum of Understanding provides for the coordination of services between IEHP and the County's California Children Services (CCS) Program and Tuberculosis (TB) Control Program. Under this Memorandum of Understanding, Riverside County will continue to provide CCS and TB services to children enrolled in the Healthy Families Program.

The Second Amendment was approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 30, 2002. This Agreement was effective until June 30, 2004. IEHP contacted the Department in June 2006 and informed that the Agreement had not been renewed. Coordination of services between the IEHP and the County's CCS and TB Control Program has continued for the period of July 1, 2004 to present.

The Third Amendment of this MOU, notwithstanding the date of execution, will be effective as of July 1, 2004 and shall continue in effect through June 30, 2005. Thereafter, the term of the MOU shall automatically be extended up to a maximum of four (4) successive one (1) year term(s) unless terminated. The renewal of this MOU is required on or before June 30, 2009, unless terminated.

The Department and IEHP will work to ensure that Agreements are reviewed annually and are submitted for approval in a timely manner.
