**BACKGROUND:**

On August 1, 2002 under RFP #97899 Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County recommended to the County of Riverside, Department of Public Social Services that Family Services of the Desert (FSD) receive funding through the Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) Time Limited Reunification Program. On September 27, 2005, Your Honorable Board approved a Form 11 (Agenda item 3.3b) authorizing the extension of the existing contracts for the Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment (CAPIT) and Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) Agreements through June 30, 2006.

Through this funding FSD provides an array of services, such as parenting education classes, in-home visits, conflict resolution, and individual, couples and family counseling to families located in the underserved communities within the Coachella Valley. The target population for these services are families that have experienced an episode of substantiated child abuse. These services are designed to facilitate the reunification of the child safely and appropriately in a timely fashion (within the 15-month period from the date in which the child is considered to have entered foster care) with the family of origin.

The federally mandated goals/objectives of the services provided under the Family Support Program are to:

- Reduce the recurrence of child abuse and neglect;
- Provide early intervention and treatment services to low-risk, at-risk families;
- Reduce the need for long-term placement services;
- Reduce the occurrence of abuse in at-risk families; and
- Reduce the occurrence of intergenerational abuse by providing victims with early and effective treatment.

Based upon the FY05/06 service levels, it was determined that an additional \$29,313 needed to be allocated to FSD to pay for services rendered.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

A total of \$29,313 has been allocated from the 06/07 fiscal year budget for these services. There is no cost to the County for these services.
