On September 10, 2003, the Sheriff's Department began law enforcement boat patrols for MWD at the Diamond Valley Lake recreational area. MWD agreed to provide a patrol boat and to fund the boat's expenses. Initially, MWD requested a dedicated Sheriff's Sergeant. On April 20, 2004, it requested the addition of a Deputy.

As a result of a service level analysis conducted by staff from both the Sheriff's Department and MWD at midyear in FY 2005-06, it was agreed that two Deputies should handle the lake patrols. The MWD's Governing Board has approved a new five-year Agreement for the provision of law enforcement at this service level. The term of the Agreement will run from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2011. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.

Since staff had foreknowledge of the service change, it budgeted accordingly in FY 2006-07, so no budget adjustments are required. Board approval of this Form 11 will authorize the necessary personnel changes for the Department.
