RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the Cooperative Funding Agreement between the District and the City of Corona; and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District.

BACKGROUND:

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the District will contribute funding to the City of Corona (City) for construction of the subject drainage improvements. Upon completion of construction, the City will accept the drainage improvements for ownership, operation and maintenance. At such time as the District completes construction of its planned Bedford Canyon Wash improvements, it may accept responsibility for operation and maintenance of certain portions of the City constructed drainage improvements.
