SUBJECT: Moratorium

Dear Supervisor Ashley

I am referring to the article under GOVERNMENT ACTION in the Press Enterprise this morning. "Riverside County Supervisor Marion Ashley on Tuesday called for a moratorium on new construction that would rely on septic tanks *in some areas in Cherry Valley*, citing the *potential* for increased water-well pollution.

- If there is to be a moratorium on building until this *potential* problem is solved DO NOT CHERRY PICK *certain areas* in Cherry Valley.

IF there is a problem, all of the unincorporated area above Brookside and up to the Riverside County line must be included.

You cannot select only a few and say they are the sole problem.

Meetings should not be held at 1:30 p.m. on a subject that affects the entire Community! In my opinion, this is done to prevent input. If you have a job, or cannot afford to drive to Riverside you are unable to attend. This takes away the public's right to have a voice in matters that will have a huge impact.

I may be unable to attend the August 29th meeting so I am requesting that this be made available as part of "Public Comment".
