SUBJECT: Consolidation of Special Elections

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve consolidation of special municipal, school district and special district elections with the November 7, 2006 Consolidated General Election and authorize the Registrar of Voters to conduct subject elections for the City of Rancho Mirage, the City of Riverside, the Banning Unified School District, the Perris School District and the Jurupa Community Services District pursuant to their respective resolutions.

BACKGROUND: California Elections Code § 10403 allows jurisdictions to request consolidation of special elections by submitting a resolution to the Board of Supervisors not later than the 88th day before the November 7, 2006 Consolidated General Election. The City of Rancho Mirage, the City of Riverside, the Banning Unified School District, the Perris School District and the Jurupa Community Services District have complied with this requirement and request consolidation of their special elections. These jurisdictions normally hold elections in the odd-numbered years or in months other than November. The measures to be placed on the ballot are attached as Exhibit A.

The department has the resources to consolidate these elections concurrently with this year's Consolidated General Election. The jurisdictions will reimburse the department based on associated direct costs.
