SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 348.4414, an Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 348

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors introduce and adopt in successive weeks an Amendment to Ordinance No. 348, an ordinance relating to Eastvale Neighborhood Preservation Overlay Zone, concerning parking restriction of recreational vehicles and parking restriction of vehicles on public street or right of way to facilitate street sweeping.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the request of Supervisor Tavaglione to prepare an Amendment to Ordinance No. 413 and in conjunction therewith to harmonize Ordinance No. 348 relating to parking restriction of recreational vehicles, County Counsel prepared Ordinance No. 348.4414. In addition, this Ordinance will provide an exception for commercial vehicles under certain specified circumstances to the parking restriction of vehicles during street sweeping hours and clarify the requirement of posting signage as a pre-requisite of enforcement, as follows:

1. By amending Section 19.503(b)(6) which will incorporate parking restriction by recreational vehicles on public street or right of way and certain areas on private property within the limits of Eastvale Neighborhood Preservation Overlay Zone.
2. By amending Section 19.503(b)(7) which will incorporate parking restriction on public street or right of way for a designated day during the week for purpose of street sweeping and provide an exception for commercial vehicles under certain specified circumstances.

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ORDINANCE NO. 348.4414

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 348
RELATING TO EASTVALE NEIGHBORHOOD PRESERVATION OVERLAY ZONE
INCLUDING UNLAWFUL RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING AND PARKING
RESTRICTED TO FACILITATE STREET SWEEPING**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 19.503(b)(6) of Ordinance 348 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“(6) Recreational vehicles shall only be parked in an enclosed garage, except as otherwise provided herein. Recreational vehicles may be parked in a side or rear yard if they are screened behind a fence or wall that is at least five (5) feet in height. For a period of not more than forty-eight (48) hours, twice a month, recreational vehicles may be parked upon a public street or right-of-way if vehicles are otherwise allowed to park there and if: (i) the vehicle is parked directly in front of the vehicle owner’s residence for the purpose of loading, unloading or cleaning the vehicle; or (ii) the vehicle is parked directly in front of a residence by a person visiting the residence and the owner of the residence has given his or her permission. When signs are posted or erected pursuant to Section 19.503(j) of this Ordinance, any recreational vehicle parked or left standing on a public street or right-of-way in violation of said parking prohibition shall be subject to citation.”

Section 2. Section 19.503(b)(7) of Ordinance 348 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“(7) Parking upon a public street or right-of-way shall be restricted for a designated day during the week in order to clear the curb-side for street sweeping. This parking restriction shall be applicable only after a street sweeping schedule for the ENPO zone is established and signs are posted or erected giving notice of the parking restriction pursuant to Section 19.503(j) of this Ordinance. Any vehicle parked or left standing on a public street or right-of-way in violation of said parking restriction shall be subject to citation, except as otherwise provided herein. The parking restriction shall not apply to the parking or standing of any commercial vehicle on a public street or right-of-way within a residential district while making pickups or deliveries of goods, wares, or merchandise from or to any building or structure located on the restricted street or highway, or for the purpose of delivering materials to be used in the repair, alteration, remodeling or reconstruction of any building or structure for which a building permit has previously been obtained.”

1 Section 3. Subsection (j) of Section 19.503 of Ordinance No. 348 is hereby added to read as
2 follows:

3 “(j) Posting Signage. The Director of Transportation shall erect or post signs in compliance
4 with Sections 22507 and 22507.6 of the California Vehicle Code giving notice of the
5 parking prohibition and restriction contained in Section 19.503(b)(6) and (7) of this
6 Ordinance. Director of Transportation means the Director of the Riverside County
7 Transportation Department and shall be equivalent to the “road commissioner” in its
8 authority and capacity for any legal requirements.”

9 Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its passage.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT CASE NO./TITLE: Ordinance No. 348.4414, Amending Ordinance No. 348

PROJECT SPONSOR: Riverside County

PROJECT LOCATION: Unincorporated areas of Riverside County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Amend Ordinance No. 348, an ordinance relating to Eastvale Neighborhood Preservation Overlay Zone, by amending Section 19.503(b)(6) which will incorporate parking restriction by recreational vehicles on public street or right-of-way and certain areas on private property, by amending Section 19.503(b)(7) which will incorporate parking restriction on public street or right way for a designated day during the week for purpose of street sweeping, and by adding Subsection (j) of Section 19.503 which will provide posting notice within street rights of way of said restrictions.


The Planning Department has found that the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA based on the following: The project is exempt from CEQA if the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects, which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

State CEQA Guidelines: Section 15051(b)3

Findings:

1. The proposal will not require the disturbance of any previously undisturbed areas.
2. The proposed will not have adverse effects upon the environment.
3. The proposal, will not individually or cumulatively, have an adverse effect on wildlife resources.
4. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
