SUBJECT: Agreement with the City of Temecula for Additional Library Services

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the chairman to sign the Ninth Amendment to provide Library Services (Additional Staff) with the City of Temecula for the period July 1 – October 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND: Since 1999, the City of Temecula has elected to fund additional library services at the current Temecula Library. This Ninth Amendment for additional services provides for a Volunteer Coordinator and two Reference Librarians for the first three months of the 2006-07 fiscal year, after which the City of Temecula will occupy the new Temecula Library, to be operated by the County Library under a separate operating agreement.
