BACKGROUND: This amendment to Ordinance 725 will reflect the increase in hourly rates for Building and Safety Code Enforcement Officers and Technicians and other department staff. This change in hourly rates is caused by increases in costs to provide code enforcement services. The rates were calculated in a fee cost study and in accordance with standard cost accounting principles and have been approved by the Auditor-Controller's Office.
