SUBJECT: TUMF Funding Agreement between the County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) and Western Riverside Council of Governments (WRCOG) for Clinton Keith Road Widening from I-15 to Copper Craft Drive.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached TUMF Funding Agreement between the County of Riverside and WRCOG, and authorize the Chairman to execute same.

BACKGROUND: The proposed project will widen Clinton Keith Road from two (2) lanes to four (4) lanes from I-15 to the city limits of Murrieta (Copper Craft Drive). Clinton Keith Road is a high priority corridor in Southwest Riverside County. It provides a connection between I-15 and I-215, and connects the communities of Wildomar, Tenaaja, and La Cresta with the City of Murrieta.

By this Agreement, WRCOG intends to distribute TUMF Zone Funds to the County for the subject project, which includes preliminary engineering, environmental studies and environmental documentation, final design, and construction. The total funding amount under this agreement is \$2,542,000.
