SUBJECT: "Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line" with the Southern California Edison Company, Cantu Galleano Ranch Road at I-15, Eastvale area and Request for Delegation of Authority to the Director of Transportation to Execute Similar Agreements up to the amount of \$75,000.00.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the "Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line" for the provision of electrical energy for the traffic signals, lighting and ramp meters to be constructed as part of the Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road and Interstate 15 freeway interchange project, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement on behalf of the County of Riverside.
2. Authorize the Director of Transportation and his designee to execute Edison Company "Contracts for Extension of Electrical Distribution Lines" on behalf of the County of Riverside up to the amount of \$75,000.00.

of Supervisors awarded the contract to construct interchange improvements at Cantu Galleano Ranch Road at Interstate 15 in the Eastvale area. That project includes the construction of traffic signals, lighting and ramp meters. Those facilities require that an electrical line extension be installed by the Southern California Edison Company. The submitted agreement provides for the line extension on the west side of the interchange, and the contract amount is \$55,552.87. A similar agreement will be required for the east side of the freeway.

Funding for the line extension has been included in the Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road and Interstate 15 project budget. Project no. A2-0421.

Execution of "Contracts for Extension of Electrical Distribution Lines" is required for the provision of electrical service when primary electrical circuits must be physically extended to the necessary service point. This is a routine agreement prepared by the Edison Company consistent with the California Public Utilities Commission's Rule 15. It is our opinion that the requested authority level will be sufficient for most future line extension costs.

Execution by the Director of Transportation or his designee will reduce administrative time and costs, and will reduce the time necessary for payment to be made to the Edison Company, enabling more timely provision of the necessary electrical service.
